The warm-up will start at 9:00 in the morning sessions and at 15:45 in the afternoon sessions.

7.-PARTICIPATION:

- The club needs to send agreement from his national federation affiliated to the Sports Committee and the Finswimming Commission.
- Each competitor must have the National Federation Licence and CMAS International Sport Licence.
- All swimmers will take part as in the 2nd World Cup as in the VII.Open.
- For the World Cup each competitor can take part in a maximum of three (3) individual races and one (1) relay.
- Each team can enrol a maximum of two swimmers for each individual race.
- Only clubs can participate.
- In addition, to take part in the VII. International Open of Ordizia classification, each swimmer can choose an extra race, 50 m surface or 400 m inmersion. (Look at the programme to know when these races are hold).

8.-CATEGORIES:

- **CMAS World Cup** will included:
 - Category (A) Senior Men & Women
 - Category (B + C + D) Junior Men & Women
- **The VII. Open International Open of Ordizia**, all participants will take part in the same category, SENIOR Men & Women.

9.- JURY: The competition jury will be compound according to the CMAS finswimming international rules.

10.- COMPETITION EQUIPMENT: All equipment used in the competition must comply with the CEMAS Competition Regulations. The competition committee will check the equipment in the reception of participants.

11.- PROVISION OF LOADS FOR DIVING TANKS: The organization will facilitate the load of the tanks to a maximum of 200 Atm pressure. Any bottle that is out of marked contrast will not be filled. The material must be given to the organization on Friday 26th February from 18:00 to 20:00.

12.- PUNTUATION:

13.-CLASIFICACION:

- In the **CMAS World Cup** there will classification for individuals and clubs.
- The **VII. Open International of Ordizia** will be ranked individually in time order.

14.-AWARDS:

- In **CMAS World Cup** gold, silver and bronze medals for each distance men and women, boys and girls will be given.
- In the **VII. Open International of Ordizia** among all the races of each swimmer, the race with more points will be considered. In this way the first three men and women will be awarded with trophée and economical prizes, as follows:
 - 1st. Trophée, Txapela and 300 Euro
 - 2°. Trophée and 200 Euro
 - 3°. Trophée and 100 Euro
- All participant clubs will receive an award.

15.-PARTICIPANT RECEPTION: The participants' reception will be hold in the "Municipal Paco Yoldi Swimming pool" on Friday 23th February 2006 from 18:00 to 20:00. During this period of time, two lines will be available for training.

16.-ENTRY:

- **Preliminary inscription** must be send to the organizer and to the CMAS HQ before 21th of January 2007 (annexe 1).
- The **final inscription** must be send to the organizer and to the CMAS HQ before 10th of February 2007 (annexes 2 and 3).

Registration fees are 15 Euros per club and 5 Euros per each swimmer. These fees must be paid at participant reception.
